**Inspection and Enforcement 88-7**

**Subject:** Color coding of annual/final maps for renewed permits.

**Effective:** April 11, 1988


**Purpose:** To establish a uniform color code to identify the areas shown to be reclaimed for years 6, 7, 8, 9, and 10.

Rule 1501: 13-4-10 (B) (2), Ohio Administrative Code, requires the perimeters of the areas affected during each mining year that are not to be reaffected during the following mining year to be designated by a solid red line and shaded as follows:

Year 1 - Blue  
Year 2 - Green  
Year 3 - Yellow  
Year 4 - Red  
Year 5 - Brown

The color coding for years six (6) through ten (10) is to be by using colored hash marks (///) and not shading within the red line. The following colored hash marks are to be used:

Year 6 - Blue Hash Marks  
Year 7 - Green Hash Marks  
Year 8 - Yellow Hash Marks  
Year 9 - Red Hash Marks  
Year 10 - Brown Hash Marks
