**VALLEY MINING D-1156 FORFEITURE PROJECT

**Project Description**

The Valley D-1156 Forfeiture Project is located in Smithfield Township, Jefferson County, Ohio. Directions to the site are as follows:

From Cadiz, Ohio take U.S. 250 East toward Bridgeport. Travel U.S. 250 for approx. 7.6 miles. Turn Left on Georgetown-Adena Rd. (C.R. 41) and travel for approx. 1.4 miles. Turn Right onto W. Main St. and travel for 1.1 miles into the town of Adena. Turn left onto N. Mill St. (turns into Smithfield-Adena Rd. at town limits) and follow for approx. 1.3 miles. Project is located on left (west side of road).

The closest address to the project site is 6735 Smithfield-Adena Rd. Adena, Ohio 43901.

The project consists of the backfilling and subsequent removal of an approx. 100 foot long diversion channel and the repair of a separate existing erosion feature by constructing an approx. 70 foot long rock channel. Temporary erosion and sediment controls include the use of silt fence and straw bale dikes. Once the site is final graded it shall be fertilized, seeded and mulched. Additional work items shall include reconstruction of a stoned access road and regrading/revegetating of a separate access road that has previously been eroded.
