Subject: Planting Report Form

Effective: October 1, 1988


Purpose: To provide a uniform form to document the completion of planting, the start of the five (5) year maintenance period, and the time for removal of siltation structures.

This Policy/Procedure Directive replaces D.A.M. #55 and the Operator's Notification of Completion of Planting form in their entirety.

The Division of Reclamation has developed the attached Planting Report Form in order to DOCUMENT and VERIFY the commencement of the five (5) year maintenance period and the time frame by which siltation structures can be removed. The form is to be filled out at the time the permanent seeding and/or planting is completed on the entire annual segment, as reported on an annual or final map. The form has instructions on the reverse side.

The form is to be submitted to the appropriate district office promptly so the Inspector can verify that the seeding and/or planting has been completed. Once verified, the applicable maintenance period and time frame will begin. This form will be of significant importance at the time of removal of siltation structures and the Phase II and Phase III Bond Releases.

If a substantial failure to the seeding and/or planting occurs and the segment has to be reseeded and/or replanted, a new form will have to be submitted.
