

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION
GENERAL CLAY BOND FORFEITURE
HOCKING COUNTY, OHIO**

Project Description

This project consists of permanently reclaiming an abandoned surface mine site, which involves grading the mine spoil to obtain positive drainage and capping the acidic spoil with on-site resoil material. Prior to backfilling the highwall an underdrain will be installed to control acid mine drainage (AMD) seepage. Several channels and drainage ways have experienced severe erosion and are in need of channel protection via Permanent Channel Lining and limestone. All disturbed areas will be revegetated and straw wattles installed to prevent erosion. The project will eliminate the sediment and AMD runoff that is currently draining from the site.

The General Clay Forfeiture Project is located in Hocking County, Starr Township, and Section 6. Site access shall be from Old US 33 / Haydenville Rd. This project shall comply with all applicable permits including but not limited to an Ohio EPA Construction General Permit for Construction Site Storm Water Runoff.

Major work items in this project include but are not limited to approximately 10,000 CY of Earthwork, 74 TON of ODOT Crushed Limestone, 3,400 LF of Straw Wattle, 207 LF of subsurface underdrain, 1,564 SY of permanent channel lining.



Directions

—From the south, take U.S. 33 West towards Nelsonville. Exist U.S. 33 W onto West Interchange Road, turn left and travel 0.3 miles. Travel through the round-a-bout and exit right on to Haydenville Road (Old US 33) and travel 3.4 miles. The project site is on your right.

—From the north, take U.S. 33 East towards Nelsonville. Take the OH-595/CR25 exit toward New Straitsville and turn right onto Haydenville Road. Travel 3.2 miles and the project site is on your left.
